

## **RIGHT TO REPORT**

If you, or someone you know, are experiencing sexual abuse or sexual harassment, Santa Fe County Detention Facility wants to know. We want you to report right away! Why?

- We want to keep YOU safe; it is our job! It is your right to be free from sexual abuse and sexual harassment.
- We want to conduct an investigation of the reported incident.
- We want to hold the perpetrator accountable for his/her actions.
- We want to provide YOU with relevant information and support services.

## **HOW TO REPORT**

Santa Fe County Detention Facility offers multiple ways to report sexual abuse and sexual harassment. Reports can be made anonymously.

- Call the PREA Coordinator at (505) 428-3116 or send a letter to 28 Camino Justicia Santa Fe, NM 87508
- Report to any staff, volunteer, contractor, or medical or mental health staff.
- Submit a grievance or a sick call slip.
- Tell a family member, friend, legal counsel, or anyone else outside the facility. They can report on your behalf by calling (505) 428-3116.
- You also can submit a report on someone's behalf, or someone at the facility can report for you using the ways listed here.
